

## Jagger Green Memorial Scholarship



The **Jagger Green Memorial Scholarship** was established in loving memory of Jagger Green, a 19-year-old lifelong resident of Slave Lake, Alberta, whose quiet kindness and generosity left a lasting impact on those around him. Jagger did not seek recognition or attention; instead, he led through his actions. When asked to help others, he most often said yes, and he did so with a sense of humour—making jokes, having fun, and bringing warmth and ease to any situation.

Jagger was deeply involved in his community. He participated in sports and school activities, valued teamwork, and found a strong sense of belonging within the gaming community. Whether through volunteering, lending a hand, or simply showing up for others, Jagger consistently demonstrated compassion, altruism, and respect.

This scholarship honours Jagger’s legacy by supporting a **Roland Michener Secondary School graduating student** who reflects these same values. The recipient will be a student who makes positive contributions to their school or community, willingly helps others, shows leadership—both quiet and visible—and demonstrates a commitment to service.

One scholarship in the amount of **\$1,000** will be awarded to a Roland Michener graduate who is pursuing a **two-year or longer post-secondary program**. This award is intended for a student who embodies kindness, community involvement, and the belief that helping others—often without being asked—is one of the most meaningful ways to lead.

**APPLICATION DEADLINE: June 1, 2026**

To be considered for the Memorial Scholarship, applicants must submit the following:

- A completed Memorial Scholarship Application
- A completed Personal Reflection section
- Proof of acceptance to a post-secondary institution (acceptance letter)
- One letter of reference from:
  - A high school teacher, guidance counsellor, or school administrator, or
  - A community member who has worked with the applicant in a volunteer capacity

The successful recipient will be notified of their award at the graduation ceremony on June 20, 2026. Proof of enrollment in Post-secondary is required from the recipient, and a cheque will be issued directly to the student.
