APPLICATION DETAILS

The Rotary Club of Slave Lake Scholarship for Outstanding Community Involvement is for one, one-time bursary of \$1000. It is awarded to a graduating high school student for exceptional community service directed towards the residents of Slave Lake and/or the MD of Lesser Slave River. The candidate's contribution(s) to the community may be demonstrated through volunteerism or leadership in extra-curricular activities. Contributions to our communities should align with the Rotary International's Four Way Test which asks the following questions:

Of the things we think, say or do:

- 1. Is it the TRUTH?
- 2. Is it fair to all concerned?
- 3. Will it build GOODWILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?
- 4. Will it be beneficial to all concerned?

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Friday, May 30th, 2025

CRITERIA

- Must be a resident of the Town of Slave Lake or the Municipal District of Lesser Slave River
- Must have graduated or be graduating high school in the region, with the intention of entering
 an accredited post-secondary institution following graduation. Please note that students
 progressing to academic upgrading for high school courses do not meet the criteria.
- Must have made a positive contribution to the community of Slave Lake or M.D. of Lesser Slave River through community service, school involvement or other areas of significance.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

A complete application consists of the following elements:

- Application information form fully completed, and all questions addressed.
- Completed attached form outlining your extra-curricular and community involvement.
- Two letters of reference; one from your high school (administrator, guidance counsellor or teacher) and one from a member of your community who has worked with you in a volunteer capacity.
- High School Transcript
- Documentation to show current post-secondary school enrollment.

JUDGING PROCEDURE

All applicants will be reviewed by a committee comprised of the members of the Slave Lake Rotary Club. The successful candidate will be selected based upon a simple combination of the following criteria:

- 1. Community Involvement & Volunteerism
- 2. Extra-Curricular Activities
- 3. Academic Performance

PRESENTATION OF AWARDS

The successful candidate will be awarded a cheque in the amount of \$500 upon the receipt of confirmation of registration at a recognized Alberta post-secondary institution.
