The Slave Lake Native Friendship Centre would like to support in the form of a bursary to a graduate of Roland Michener Secondary School or Lakeside Outreach School. Two bursaries of \$1000 will be awarded to the successful recipient(s) who is planning to further his/her education at a recognized post-secondary institution. The intent of the bursary is to award monetary funds to a graduate who has met the following criteria:

- 1) Students who self-identify as Status Indian/First Nations, Non-Status Indian/First Nations, Métis or Inuit.
- 2) Students must have graduated from Roland Michener in the last two years or are planning to graduate this school year.
- 3) Students have conditional acceptance/ acceptance to a post secondary school (2 -4 year program)

Applications can be returned to the Career Coaches by June 1, 2025 of the year in which the student is graduating. All questions can be brought forward to the Career Coaches.

The successful recipient will be notified of their award at the 2025 graduation ceremony. Once proof of enrollment is received from the recipient; a cheque will be issued to the student.
