School Mark Advantage Score:

The School Mark Advantage Score is an indication of what degree are students advantaged or disadvantaged due to differences in school-awarded marks and diploma examination marks, particularly since they are influenced by those same differences on a provincial basis. To determine the school Mark Advantage Score use the provincial data entitled Summary Results: Five School Years comparing the differences between the school-awarded marks minus the diploma examination marks for both the province and the school. Then subtract the provincial advantage from the school advantage.
