HOMEWORK

Background

HPSD believes that homework has educational value and it may be necessary for professional staff to assign meaningful work that is beyond classroom hours.

Procedures

- 1. The responsibility for developing a homework policy for each school is delegated to the Principal in consultation with the school's professional staff and should take into account:
 - 1.1. the relevancy and appropriateness of the assignment;
 - 1.2. the grade/ability level of the students; and
 - 1.3. the coordination of the assignments by all teachers.
- 2. Homework assignments should be an extension of the material studied and be realistic in terms of:
 - 2.1. timelines for task completion;
 - 2.2. teacher expectations; and
 - 2.3. student overall life balance.
- 3. A copy of school homework guidelines should be contained in the school handbook.
