TWO Scholarships will be awarded each year if more than one suitable applicant applies

The Medicine Shoppe Pharmacy in Slave Lake is locally owned and operated and is dedicated to contributing to our community now, and for years to come. This scholarship was established to award students graduating from the Slave Lake/Kinuso area who intend to pursue studies in a health-related field.

Eligibility:

To be eligible for this award, applicants must:

1. Be graduating from high school in Slave Lake area or Kinuso
2. Not have already been awarded a major non-repayable scholarship over \$5000 (does not include Student Loans from the Government or a Financial Institution)
3. Be accepted by a recognized post-secondary education institution in Canada for a health-related program and plan to attend that institution in the fall of the same year.

Selection Criteria

Scholarship recipient(s) will be selected on the basis of: academic performance, community involvement, and a character reference. Preference will be given to students specifically pursuing pharmacy related studies (pharmacy assistant, technician or BSc. in Pharmacy). **We still encourage students pursuing studies in any health-related field to apply** (Nursing, Paramedicine, Dental Hygiene etc.) Preference will be given to applicants attending a school in Alberta.
