

Guidelines for Awarding the Jamie Lukan Memorial Scholarship

The Jamie Lukan Memorial Scholarship is to be awarded annually to two Roland Michener Secondary School graduates. A bursary of \$1,000 will be awarded to each of the two recipients who are planning to further his/her education at a post-secondary institution. The intent of the bursary is to award monies to a graduate who has met the following criteria:

- 1) Graduate must be entering a further education program that leads to either a career in the trades or technology area and/or a student who will be entering a post-secondary program in physical education or the recreation field. (related fields of study may be considered where not one of the applicants meets either of the above criteria.)
- 2) Written essay describing specifically which program he/she is planning to enter and why he/she has chosen this area.
- 3) Academics – Average will be calculated based on the following:
 - a. English 30-1 or English 30-2
 - b. Highest level in a math course
 - c. Highest level in a science course
 - d. Ten credits is Career And Technology Studies (C.T.S.)
 - e. Highest level Registered Apprenticeship Course will be used instead of 5 credits of C.T.S. where applicable.

Criteria items two and three will be equally weighted in assessing each candidate.

Applications can be returned to the Career Coaches by June 1 of the year in which the student is graduating from Roland Michener Secondary School.
