LONG SERVICE AWARDS

Background

HPSD believes in officially recognizing the services of long-term employees.

Procedures

- 1. In recognition of service to The High Prairie School Division, employees will receive an award for five years of service, and an award for every five years of service thereafter.
- 2. Retirees who have been employed by the Board for at least 10 years and are at least 50 years of age will receive a recognition gift.
- 3. Long Service recipients will receive a congratulatory letter and gift.
- 4. Teachers who have been nominated for the Edwin Parr Award or the Excellence in Teaching Award will be recognized by HPSD for their outstanding efforts to the teaching profession.
- 5. Awards will be presented at a suitable occasion or delivered to the school for distribution.
 - 5.1. Award recipients and a spouse/guest will be invited to attend at no charge.
 - 5.2. HPSD employees, who are non-recipients, and their spouse/guest may attend for a nominal fee to be determined by the Administration.
 - 5.3. Awards recipients of twenty-five years or more and retirees may invite guests at the same cost charged to non-recipients.
 - 5.4. Executive Council members and their spouse/guest will be invited to attend Long Service award receptions at no charge.
 - 5.5. Principals, Directors, Supervisors, and Managers, and their spouse/guest, will be invited to attend at no charge.
- 6. Award recipients will be acknowledged by the Board Chair and/or the local trustee(s).
- 7. The following are guidelines for calculating period of service:
 - 7.1. HPSD paid leave of absence will be credited.
 - 7.2. Secondments and Teacher Exchanges will be credited.
 - 7.3. Continuous part-time employees are credited for a full year's service for a full school year worked.
 - 7.4. Partial school years of seven months or more will be credited as a full year.
 - 7.5. Substituting and internship will not be credited.
