



Tolko Forestry Scholarship

Tolko is dedicated to planting the seeds of success in our local communities by investing in our community's youth through scholarship. We believe that some of our best employees come from the communities in which we do business and want to assist with their development and growth. To further this initiative, we have set up the Tolko Forestry Scholarship with your school.

The Tolko Forestry Scholarship is awarded annually to one student of the Roland Michener Secondary School in their graduating year. One thousand dollars (\$1,000) will be awarded to a student planning to further his/her education at a post-secondary institution. The application deadline for this scholarship is June 1st.

Guidelines:

The intent of this scholarship is the award of monies to graduates who have met the following criteria:

- 1) **Area of Study:** Although priority is given to students pursuing studies in the forestry sector, all applicants are welcome.
- 2) **Academics:** The student must be in good standing in his or her school and be on track to graduate at the end of the school year.
- 3) **Tolko Connection:** The student's exposure to Tolko as a company through RAP, ICEA, other programs or a family member working at Tolko. If the student has not had any direct exposure to Tolko, what do they know about the company.
- 4) **Volunteer Experience / Work Experience:** The student's experience volunteering within the school or community and/or their work experience.

Tolko would like to get to know you! Please submit a short essay on why you believe you would be a great candidate for the Tolko Forestry Scholarship, highlighting your desired area or study, exposure to or knowledge of Tolko/the forestry industry and your volunteer/work experience. Your essay should address the following 4 questions. Please type and attach on a separate sheet to your application.

- 1) Who you Are: What do you like to do, what are your
- 2) interests and where do your passions lie?
- 3) Area of Study: What is your desired area of study and why are you pursuing that area?
- 4) Connection to Tolko or Forestry: Do you have a connection to Tolko through a program or relative? If not, what do you know about Tolko and the forestry industry?
- 5) Volunteer/Work Experience: How have you helped your community or school through volunteering and what have you gain from the experience? What work experience have you had and what have you gained from the experience?

Please attach High School transcripts and your current school awarded second semester marks with your application and essay.
