

OVER AGE STUDENTS

Background

HPSD believes that there are occasions where over age students would benefit from enrollment in public education. HPSP may provide educational services to over age students if space, appropriate programming and resources are available.

Definition

Over Age - is 19 years of age or older as of September 1 of the current school year.

Procedures

1. General

- 1.1. HPSP may provide educational services to over age students if an appropriate program with sufficient student space exists.
- 1.2. Non funded students must pay the per credit fee set annually by HPSP.
- 1.3. Requests for Service for Over Age Students
 - 1.3.1. Requests for educational service shall be made to the principal.
 - 1.3.2. The principal shall make an assessment of suitability of the student for the program requested, available space, and resources.
 - 1.3.3. The principal shall make a recommendation to the Superintendent to accept or deny enrollment.
 - 1.3.4. The principal shall communicate the decision of the Superintendent, in writing, to the student.
