School buses will operate if the Evacuation Alert is more than four hours. **If the municipality declares a four-hour evacuation alert or less, buses will NOT operate.** Parents/guardians will be asked to pick up their children in the event that buses cannot operate.



The school and division will monitor air quality. Using available information, decisions will be made on staying inside for recess/breaks or any other measures needed for student safety.
