



GUIDELINES FOR APPLICATION TO THE **MARVIN ARNESON MEMORIAL BURSARY**

The Marvin Arneson Bursary is awarded yearly to a Graduate of a Slave Lake school. A Bursary of \$1000 will be awarded to a student who is planning to further his or her education at a Post-Secondary Institution. The intent of the bursary is to award monies to a graduate who has met the following criteria:

1. Graduate must be entering a post-Secondary program related to forestry/pulp industry. **Enrolment must be confirmed before award is granted.**
2. Academics – English 30, Math, Sciences, Career & Technology Studies, and Registered Apprenticeship courses could be used for evaluation. A copy of the applicant's latest report card is required. **(50%)**
3. An essay, describing specifically which program(s) the applicant is planning to enter and the reason(s) behind this decision is to accompany the application. **(30%)**
4. Involvement in extra-curricular activities and community organizations should be detailed in the essay. **(20%)**

Applications can be obtained at reception and have been supplied to local schools.
