John Perkinson was a longtime volunteer for the Slave Lake Volunteer Fire Department (Lesser Slave Regional Fire Service). He personified the word volunteer. He was always repairing and improving fire department equipment, trucks and tools. He was always the first with his hand up for volunteering at community events. He was an active volunteer for cadets, Citizens on Patrol as well as a foster parent helping youth in need. After his passing in 2013 we wanted to set up a bursary in his name. Successful applicants will show patterns in light of John's model.

Two \$500 bursaries are available to graduating students for post-secondary education support. Preference will be given to residents of Slave Lake and MD 124 going into programs in Health Careers, Emergency Services or Trades programs. Students with volunteer or community service will also have a better chance to be selected. Recipients should demonstrate their volunteerism, education plan, and how they wish to contribute to their community. Winners are selected by a panel consisting of four (4) volunteer Firefighters and Search & Rescue members from Lesser Slave Regional Fire & Rescue Society and one Perkinson family member.

Your application package should include the following:

- Essay (500) words or less outlining how the bursary will help you achieve your goals. Please highlight any leadership roles, volunteer work or community involvement.
- Three (3) reference letters in support of the application.
- Successful applicants will need to produce an acceptance letter or confirmation of enrollment from the educational institution. This may be submitted later if not available by the deadline.
