Guidelines for Awarding the Slave Lake Legacy Scholarship

The Slave Lake Legacy Scholarship is to be awarded annually to two graduates of Slave Lake area schools including Slave Lake alumni. Two bursaries of \$1000.00 will be awarded to students who are planning to further their education at a post-secondary institution. The intent of the bursary is to award monies to graduates who have met the following criteria:

- Area of study: Priority will be given to a student pursuing studies in the arts, fine arts, or humanities. Examples include a Bachelor of the Arts, a Bachelor of Fine Arts, journalism, and media studies.
- **2. Academics:** The student must be in good standing in his or her school. A copy of the applicant's latest transcript is required.
- **3. Essay:** The student must submit a written essay of 500 words describing why he/she has chosen this area of study.
- **4. Academics:** Candidate must have completed Grade 12 in a Slave Lake school and attained an overall average of 65%.

Criteria items two and three will be equally weighed in assessing each candidate.

Presentation of Award – The successful candidates will be awarded a cheque in the amount of \$1000.00 upon the receipt of confirmation of registration at a recognized post-secondary institution.

Applications can be obtained from the school, and returned to the Career Coach office for submission. **Deadline for applications is June 1st.**
