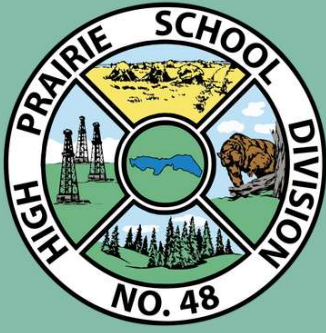

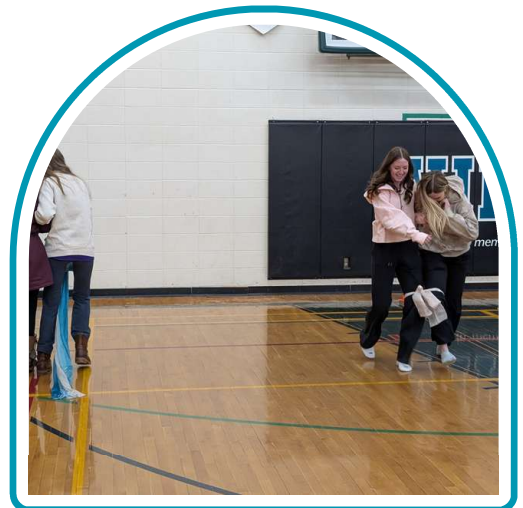

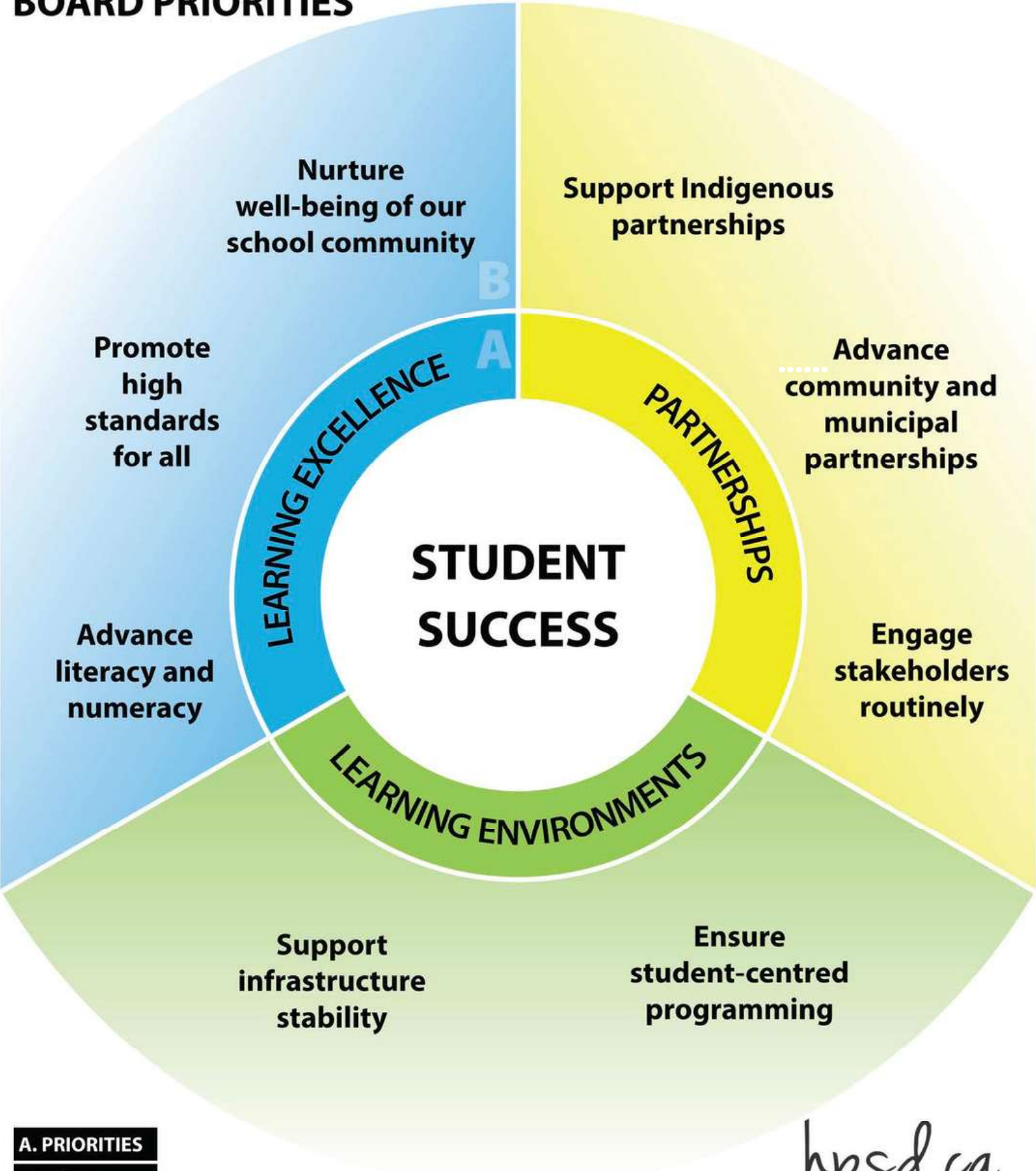
MENTORSHIP
